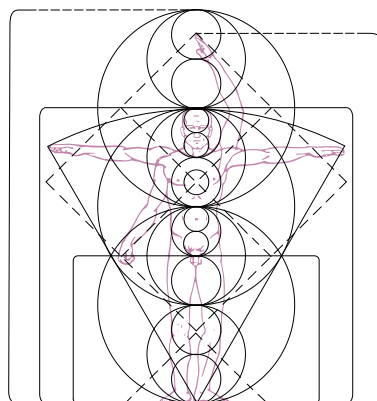


CHAPTER NINE - THAT'S AMORE

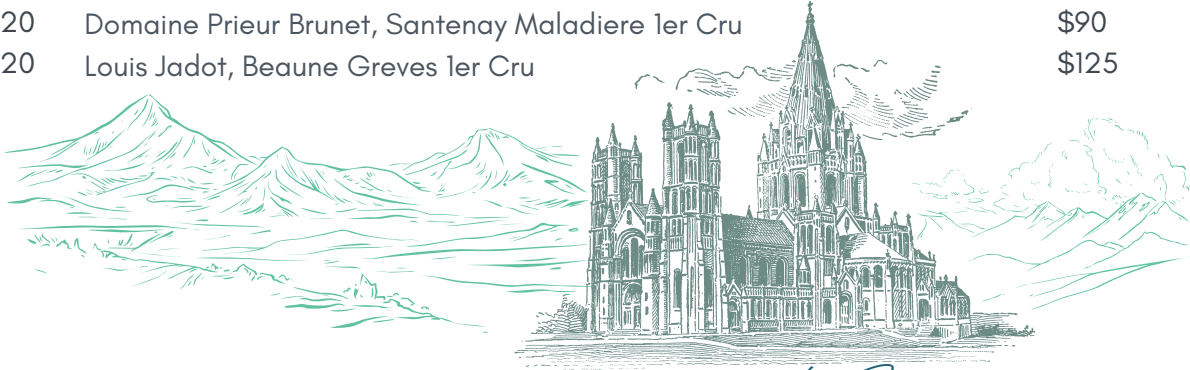
